- _____ 2. **High School Division** - Be a graduating senior attending a Polk County High School or studying with a Polk County teacher.
College Division - Be a freshman, sophomore or junior music major attending a Polk County College or studying with a Polk County teacher.
- _____ 3. **High School Division** - Have a 3.5 weighted GPA or better.
College Division - Have a 3.25 GPA or better.
- _____ 4. Submit an official transcript with a school seal.
- _____ 5. Include a personal letter giving relevant information about himself/herself.
- _____ 6. Submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher in his/her field.
- _____ 7. Submit a letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
- _____ 8. Agree to perform at a Lakeland Music Club meeting on either April or May of 2019.
